

Which Georgia Legislative Exemption Exam Do I Need?

Georgia Constitution: *Have you taken and passed a United States / American Government course in college, in the state of Georgia?*

YES* → You **DO NOT** need to take the Georgia Constitution Exemption Exam

NO → You **DO** need to take the Georgia Constitution Exemption Exam

Georgia History: *Have you taken and passed a United States History survey course (either “to 1865/77” or “since 1865/77”) in college, in the state of Georgia?*

YES* → You **DO NOT** need to take the Georgia History Exemption Exam

NO → You **DO** need to take the Georgia History Exemption Exam

Please Note: This is a generalized view of your situation. Please check with your academic advisor regarding your Georgia Legislative Exemption status before requesting and completing the exams.
